Goodhope will implement policies and practices in line with or exceeding the leading industry sustainability standards on No Deforestation, No Peat Development, No Human Exploitation, and supply chain traceability.

Goodhope is committed to apply the best management practices in relation to conservation of High Carbon Stock (HCS) forests, High Conservation Value (HCV) areas, and peat land within its supply chain.

Goodhope will create a fully transparent and traceable supply chain down to the level of its plantations, inclusive of smallholders. The company commits to demonstrate full traceability for all commodities to the mill and plantation level, including from all subsidiaries, associates and third party suppliers on or before 4th May 2019.


Goodhope will develop new association and acquisition procedures to ensure that Goodhope, its subsidiaries, associates and third-party suppliers comply with this procedure in future.
